If studs are rusty, clean with a wire brush prior to installing lug nuts. Start lug nuts by hand to insure proper thread size and prevent cross threading. Tighten lug nuts in a progressive criss-cross pattern to the recommended torque specification for your trailer. For best results, use a torque wrench and socket for final tightening. Lug nuts should be retorqued after the first 25 miles of towing. It is not recommended to use an impact wrench.
